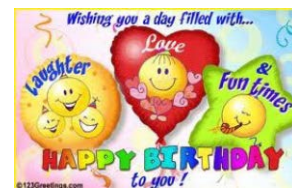
### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THE TREASURER!!!
