## ADDITION TO ADVOCACY COMMITTEE REPORT

Zonta Says NO Campaign Launch in the Park, Sunday 24 November 2013, 10.00am to 12midday:

Thankyou to all orange- clad Zontians and HonZons for such valuable assistance in this initiative.

Our TEAM (Together Everyone Achieves More) effort is outstandingly apparent when broken down into its component parts as follows:

 applying to the Moreton Bay Regional Council for permission to use the selected Apex Park site on our chosen date and for permission to erect a banner in the community advertising area the week before the event (Chris)

- organizing the making of the Zonta Says NO banner and bookmarks to be distributed (Sara)
