From ZI

ZI President, Lyn McKenzie, has recently undertaken a site visit to Benin, Nigeria to review the ZIF edutainment project which is at a key phase. Her blog on her visit is available on the ZI website (<http://www.zonta.org/NigeriaSiteVisit2014.aspx>)



In her blog she says “the TV series from Soul City is due to launch next month following extensive preparations. These preparations included: deciding the focus of the campaign - domestic violence; the entertainment medium - TV series; and then engaging stakeholders in coming to these conclusions. We met a number of key stakeholders during our visit; some of them contributed to the decision on the form of edutainment - TV series - and also preparing for the support required for women and girls who come forward as a result of seeing the series. These stakeholders included the Nigerian Police and leaders of the Market Women’s Association. Further potential champions of the campaign came as a result of our visit”.

Her blog goes on to say “This project will certainly raise awareness of the issue and start to challenge cultural norms and attitudes which will, over time, result in a reduction in domestic violence. It also will build the capacity of NGOs working in this space. It is essentially provoking the community to discuss domestic violence, a matter that is currently seen to be “private” and something kept in the family and which has been tolerated as a result.

Check out the full blog to gain a better understanding of one of our perhaps less understood ZIF ZISVAW projects – “edutainment.”
