## **Beijing Platform for Action turns 20**

When we consider our service project proposals each year we take into consideration the Beijing Platform for Action. In September 1995, 189 governments, 17,000 participants and 30,000 activists came together to adopt the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action.

This document was the most progressive blueprint ever for advancing women's rights and gender equality. It agreed on concrete steps to create a world where each woman and girl could exercise her freedoms and choices, and realize all her rights, such as to live free from



violence, to go to school, to participate in decisions and to earn equal pay for equal work.

In recognition of the 20th anniversary of this historic agreement (2015) UN Women has just launched an epic campaign "Empowering Women - Empowering Humanity: Picture It". Despite it being 20 years since the blueprint was agreed, gender equality is still a distant dream. This UN Women campaign is a global campaign that's asking each of us to imagine a world where gender equality and women's empowerment is a reality, and to play our part to make it happen.


