WOMEN WITH DISABILITIES

* Women and girls with disabilities make up 20% of the Australian population, but are 40% more likely to be the victims of domestic violence than women without disabilities.

* More than 70% of women with disabilities have been victims of violent sexual encounters at some time in their lives.

* The rate of sexual victimisation of these women is 4 - 10 times higher than for other women.

* 67% of women reported experiencing harassment during mental health hospitalisation.

* 90% of women with an intellectual disability have been subjected to sexual abuse, with more than 68% of these being abused before they were 18 years old.

* Crimes of violence against women with a disability are grossly under-reported and when they are reported, they are inadequately investigated, remain unsolved or result in minimal sentences.

* Women and young women with a disability can also be subjected to specific forms of abuse related to their impairment- controlling access to medication ; mobility; threats to withdraw care or to institutionalise; forced sterilisation; terminating pregnancies; abuse of Power of Attorney; forced institutionalisation; withholding medications; forced marriage; sexual slavery.
