It was time also to review our membership details and ensure that the data held by ZI and District is accurate. This review also provided a good opportunity to refresh our knowledge on the structure of Zonta and the Rules relative to membership e.g. the classification structure and the requirement for diversity in membership.

Breast Cancer Network Australia Forums



Two BCNA Forums were held in City Hall, Brisbane and, assisted by Anne Kuhnemann from Brisbane River Club and Leida Pirts from Brisbane Metro Breakfast, Irene and Ros staffed a stall during the forums to promote the work of Clubs throughout District 22 in the making and distribution of Zonta Breast Care Cushions and Drainage Bags.

Samples provided by Clubs were on display as well as literature about the cushions and the Clubs that make them and the hospitals which are supplied with the cushions. This was a great opportunity to promote our District and distribute the new District 22 Brochure and Breast Cushion pamphlet which are now available on the District 22 website. It was also wonderful to have women who have received a cushion come up and say "thank you" for the cushion.

Mothers Day Gifts for Madonna House



Six small but beautifully wrapped parcels were given to the staff at Madonna House to give to the children of the women staying there to then give to their Mums on Mothers Day. As well as the gifts special hand made Mothers Day cards were supplied so that the children could write their own message for their Mum on her day.



Advocacy

The District has written to both the Federal and State Governments this past month on two different issues of concern to Zontians.

Our District Governor wrote to the Prime Minister, with copies to the Leader of the Opposition and other relevant Ministers and Shadow Ministers. The submission to the Prime Minister (a) congratulated her Government on action taken to address Female Genital Mutilation in Australia, (b) expressed support for her Government's new laws which criminalise forced marriage, forced labour and organ trafficking, and (c) strongly advocated that her Government endorse Recommendation 6 of the Committee of Inquiry into Multiculturalism in Australia (viz. "that the Government promotes the message that multiculturalism entails both a respect for cultural diversity and a commitment to the framework of Australian laws and values which underpin social cohesion") in order to help eliminate illegal customary practices. The letter to the Leader of the Opposition expressed the same views.

The other submission was to the Queensland Premier and other relevant Members of the Queensland Parliament expressing concern over the reduction of funding in the 2012 -2013 Budget for specialist homelessness services, including crisis shelters for women and children experiencing domestic and family violence (DFV), as well as cuts to services which provide low-rental housing for these women (and their children) when they 'exit' a shelter. The letter further referred to the additional services offered at these DFV centres which support their attempts to break the cycle of violence having also been adversely affected by these funding cuts.

The submission requested that in the 2013-2014 Budget consideration be given to increasing funding for domestic and family violence shelters, as well as providing low-rental accommodation assistance for persons on low incomes or social security benefits where they are in rental stress (i.e. where they need to spend more than 30 per cent of their available income after tax on rent).
