

ZONTA CLUB BURDEKIN BY LAWS

1. MEMBERSHIP

Executives and professionals, women and men in decision making positions, who support the Objects of Zonta, are eligible for membership. To be invited to membership, a person must be actively engaged in a recognised business or profession. Actively engaged means 50 per cent of the time.

2. NOTIFICATION OF PROSPECTIVE MEMBERSHIP

The club membership shall be notified of a candidate before an invitation to become a member is extended.

3. REINSTATEMENT OF MEMBER DROPPED FOR NON PAYMENT OF DUES

A member dropped for non payment of dues may be reinstated, provided that any obligataions are met and the reinstatement fee is paid.

4. LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Leave of absence may be granted to member in good standing upon the recommendation of the Board such leave not to exceed one year. Payment of Zonta International and District dues and fees shall be required. Payment of club dues shall be left to the decision of the Board.

5. ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

5.1 Any member, who is absent from all club meetings to two consecutive months, without excuse deemed adequate in the opinion of the Board, shall be notified that membership may be forfeited. Should absence continue for another month following this notice, the Board shall notify the member that membership is forfeited.

- 5.2 All apologies shall be received directly by the Attendance Officer by the deadline set in the notice of meeting.
- 5.3 In the case of non-attendance without an apology, members shall be invoiced for the cost of the meal as well as the usual costs.
- 5.4 All apologies shall entail a \$5 donation to the general account.

6. TERM OF OFFICE - 2 YEARS

6.1 No officer, or director is eligible to serve more than two consecutive years in the same office.6.2 At least 4 directors are required.

7. MEETING SCHEDULE

Meetings shall be held on the second Tuesday of each month except January when no meeting is held.

8. CLUB YEAR

- 8.1 The club's fiscal year shall be from April 1 to March 31.
- 8.2 The Nomination Committee shall be elected by February.
- 8.3 The election meeting month is April.
- 8.4 The Annual meeting month is May.

9. MEETING QUORUM

Not less than one-fourth of the members shall constitute a quorum.

10. CLUB DUES

The club's annual dues shall be determined by the Finance Committee prior to the end of the financial year.

11. PARLEAMENTARY AUTHORITY

The Parliamentary Authority to be used by the club shall be N.E. Renton. May 1998
