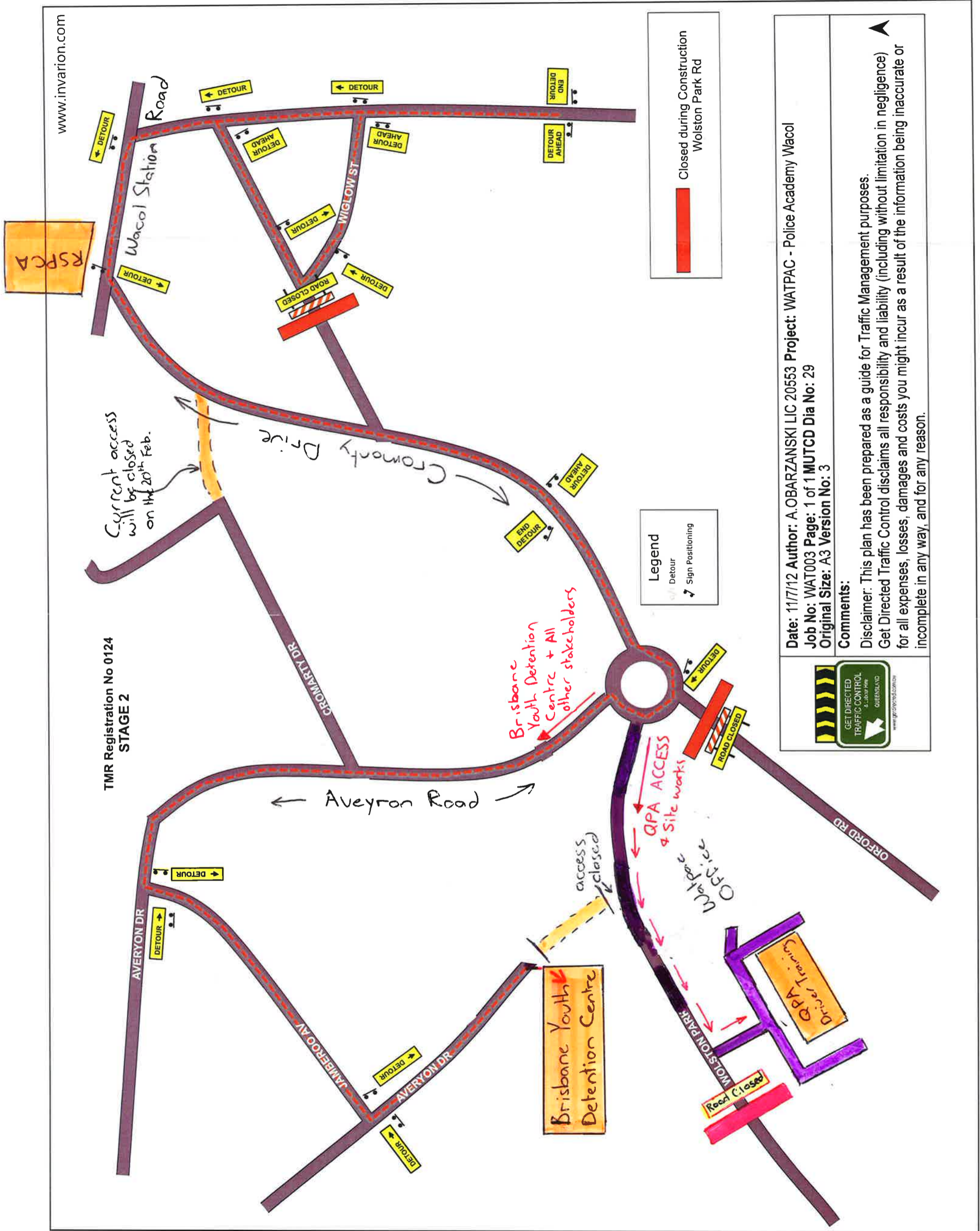
## TRAVELING TO BYDC
