Dear Zontians,

And NEVER let boys be mean to you!

As Zontians committed to the improved status of women, let us promise Allison Baden-Clay that we will <u>never again</u> put up with abuse, putdowns, ridicule, and betrayal of us as women, as colleagues, as wives and as mothers.

#### Vale Blair Wilson


