SERVICE COMMITTEE

We had our meeting on Tuesday 2nd February.

Roles and Responsibilities: Discussed and decided to keep the same as last year.

A Brave Life: Donation of \$300 paid on 17th February. Joan emailed a flyer for the IWD Luncheon to Mel Redsell to see if she would attend our function with the possibility of a presentation but she is unable to attend as she has another commitment.

Be Brave: Four schools have responded to date who wish to partake in this program. Those being – Bellmere State School, Minimbah State School, Morayfield East State School, Caboolture East State School. Since the meeting, Morayfield East State School has declined to participate. Patricia has offered the program to DBay Flexi Learning and they have decided to participate.

Birthing Kits: Ordered online Friday 29th January. Automatic confirmation received. Sarah has organised the use of the hall at Hope Pointe Church to pack kits on Saturday 17th April. We have organised a plastic folding day at Sue's residence for Tuesday 13th April, bring food to share.

Breast Care: On Thursday 4th Joan went to see prospective member Karen Whalan who has offered to make some Seatbelt Buddies. Gave her some stuffing, she has already made 6, which I collected. Joan has made 28 Turbans. Rita is in the process of making another 25 Drainage Bags. Thank you both Karen and Rita — your contributions are greatly appreciated. Lyn has advised that Karen and herself have made another 12 Seatbelt Buddies. Joan and Sue met with the Craft Group at Beachmere Bay on Thursday 11th and Joan took along samples and information about making Seatbelt Buddies and Drainage Bags as well as some stuffing and velcro. Joan also discussed the possibility of them making some Turbans. If possible Sue and Joan will go back on the 25th for a follow up.

Joan delivered 20 Breast Cushions, 15 Drainage Bags and 10 Turbans to the Breast Care Nurse on the 8th February. Jean at Plantation has taken 4 Turbans and is making a donation.

Creating Confidence Program: Joan has emailed Jo Arthur regarding the allocation of funds and possible presentation of big cheque at IWD. Jo has confirmed that she will be attending the IWD luncheon.

Inclusion Swimming Program: Pam has notified Lee Street Special School that funds are available. \$2,000. They are starting swimming next week as well as late April and again at the end of the year.

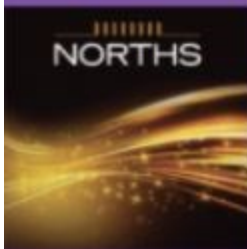
