Zonta Capricornia Living Treasure Award

Terms of Reference

The following, personal qualities and attributes, is the primary information sought of nominees to be considered as a *Zonta Living Treasure*.

- Capacity and capability to Achieve and/or record of Achievements.
- Capacity to Inspire and/or Influence others by one's achievements.
- Capacity to bring about Change that is positive for a group, community, town, city, region, state, in the following areas -

Social	Environmental	Cultural
Financial	Economic	Education
Political	Professional	Spiritual
Business	Sporting	

- Capacity to share, empower and or lead others by one's achievements and skills.

The Judging Panel will use the information as a key source of data prior to seeking additional information (if necessary) to quantify the qualities and attributes of each applicant.

Criteria

- Applicants must be women aged 16 years and over.
- Whilst applicants must have lived for a period of time in Capricornia, they do not have to satisfy any time consideration in respect to living in the Rockhampton Regional Council or Livingstone Shire Council areas for a significant period of time.
- They may have left the community, but their impact has not.

- It will be the quality of the applicant's capacity to bring about real and meaningful change to a community and / or their potential to do so.
- This is especially important for young applicants. It is our belief that making a tangible and valued difference to a community, even within a relatively short time, is far more important.

Nominations are sought from areas covered by the Rockhampton Regional Council and the Livingstone Shire Council.

The Judging Panel

The Judging Panel of three will comprise:

Three women nominated, on an annual basis, by the Zonta Club of Rockhampton Inc., including representatives from Sponsors and the community.

Recognition of the Living Treasure
