What is **Zonta Rose Day**? (taken from information on the

Zonta Club of Pasadena's and Zonta Internationa's web pages).

The Yellow rose has long been a symbol of

Zonta International, with presentations of yellow roses adorning many Zonta items from stationary to jewellery and clothing, and real roses are used in Club charter and anniversary celebrations.

1983, then Lieutenant In Governor of District 16 (New Zealand), Valerie Webster, proposed that a breed of roses be developed as a living symbol of Zonta International. The renowned England-based Harkness nurserv Roses worked to cultivate the flower. while Zontian Maureen Ross of Ross Roses in Adelaide. Australia, enabled it to be introduced at the 1984 Convention in Sydney.

There are two official Zonta roses: The "Hartana" and the "Harflow" rose but other varieties of "Zonta" yellow roses have also been produced in Austria, Australia and the U.K.

The 8 March has been designated by ZI as Zonta Rose Day to be celebrated in conjunction with International Women's Day.

Its purpose is:

- to promote recognition of International Women's Day
- to increase the visibility of Zonta International
- to be a potential fundraiser through selling roses.

For example: Some Clubs distribute yellow roses within their communities on 8 March, accompanied with printed information about Zonta International and IWD.

So: - Happy International Women's Day AND Zonta Rose Day.

I look forward to seeing those who can make lunch on the 8th, and to those who can't make the 8th, see you at dinner on the 9th.
