PRESIDENT'S REPORT

This year has seen the club take some positive steps towards much needed revitalisation. In December we were pleased to induct two new members to our club, to offset our dwindling numbers. Irene Kinder and Mel Ablitt bring much needed injection of fresh enthusiasm to our small but dedicated band of long term Zontians.

Our quest for a permanent meeting place has seen us meet at The Pineapple Hotel and the Bulimba Council Library. This last venue has the virtue of enabling us the use of a private room, a luxury our small number does not allow us to afford in commercial premises. It is to be hoped that the use of this facility will enable us to invite guest speakers to our meetings and improve our meeting program in ways which were not possible in public spaces.

In spite of our small membership we have continued to supply Breast cushion to the Mater Private Hospital and to other hospitals and patients on request. Our Sunday morning working bees continue to be very productive as our numbers are supplemented by community helpers. In addition we gratefully receive cushions sewn by other generous supporters. This project is our major service project and the many letters of thanks that we receive from women recovering from breast cancer surgery encourage us to continue this worthwhile activity.

We again awarded three scholarships to former Balmoral High students pursuing tertiary studies and were delighted to have two of the girls and a Deputy Principal from the school at our April meeting.

At Christmas time we were able to present gift packs of toiletries to the Murri Sisters and to Madonna House thanks to the generosity of our members. We have continued to supply exit packs of kitchen items to Madonna House to assist victims of domestic violence who are embarking on a fresh start.

We were saddened at the end of last year by the death of our former member and past president Glenda Page. We sent a donation of \$300 dollars to the Zonta International Foundation in her memory. The money was divided equally among the three projects, Amelia Earhart scholarships, the Jane M Klausman awards and International Projects.

Following the devastating floods of January 2011, which affected the business of one of our own members, we became aware of the plight of older single women who as retirees would struggle to replace possessions which the insurance companies refused to pay for. To this end we assisted a woman in the situation with a donation of \$1000.

In September 2011 some of our members attended the District 22 Conference and we will be represented at the International Convention later this year.

This year we have been limited in our fund raising activities as we were not able to hold either the Wine and Cheese afternoon or the Antiques fair. A sausage sizzle at the Ipswich Antique Centre and the sale of the Entertainment Books yielded some funds to augment our reserves in meeting our obligations to our ongoing projects.

Our challenge for the coming year remains the need to increase our membership and to continue to serve Zonta's aims.

FUNDRAISING & SERVICE

Service Projects

a) Zonta Breast Care Cushions

Members continue to meet to stuff, sew and package our Zonta Breast Cushions which are then distributed to predominantly the Mater Private Hospital but also the Princess Alexandra Hospital as needs arise and we respond to ad hoc requests.

b) Balmoral State High School Bursaries

The Club continued with its project of awarding a scholarship to a Grade Twelve girl from Balmoral State High School to encourage and assist her to continue with further education. The scholarship provides financial support of \$500 per year over three years subject to continuing enrolment and satisfactory results.

The Club is now supporting three students with the students invited to a meeting early in each year to meet members and speak on the progress of their studies.

c) Support for Madonna House

The Club continued its support for the women staying at Madonna House. Our support included:

- Provision of Kits of household goods to assist the women leaving Madonna House to establish their own home;
- Christmas gifts for the women

The gifts were made possible by the generous donations of items from members and friends, supplemented by funds from our Fundraising Account.

d) International Service Projects through Zonta International Foundation

The Club is committed to supporting the ZIF programs forwarding one-third of funds raised to the International Service Projects.

Fundraising

Sadly our major fundraiser the Antiques and Collectibles Fair had to be cancelled this year so our fundraising was limited with no major fundraiser held.

- Jill continued with the sale of the Entertainment Books; and
- The Club held a valuation day and sausage sizzle at the Ipswich Antique Centre.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The Nominating Committee is charged with the role of presenting to the Club a Slate of Candidates for the coming Zonta year (2012-2013).

In preparing this Slate, the Committee took into consideration previous positions held by Club Members and opportunities for future development. We also had in mind the outcomes of our Planning Meeting in February and the Draft Club Strategic Plan and the future directions of the Club.

TREASURER'S REPORT

For this year we made a deficit of \$1,939.58

This was due to scholarships that were given to 3 recipients who attended Balmoral State High School. Two of these students, Zenia Wood and Rebecca Harris, have received \$500 each in the previous year. The third recipient, Kaitlyn Sichter, has received the scholarship of \$500 for the first time this year.

In addition, we gave \$1000 to a flood victim who lives at Sinnamon Park to assist with purchase of furniture which was lost in the flood in January 2011.

Our sources of fundraising this year have been from:

- Donation \$110.00
- Entertainment Books \$260.00
- Valuation Day \$137.86

We have given \$600 to Zonta International for International Projects which represents one-third of funds raised in the 2010-2011 year.

Our General Account has made a surplus of \$239.80. We no longer hold our meetings at a restaurant so there has been no need for us to collect meeting money to cover the cost of a meal. This has made our monthly meetings much simpler in terms of collection of money.

1. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements are a general purpose financial report that have been prepared in accordance with the Australian Accounting Standards, other mandatory professional reporting requirements, and the requirements of the Associations Incorporations Act (Qld). The financial statements have also been prepared on the basis of historical costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets. Cost is based on the fair values of the condsideration given in exchange for the assets. The accounting policies have been consistently applied, unless otherwise stated.

The following is a summary of the material accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the financial statements.

Income Tax

No income tax is payable as the Association is an exempt organistion under the Income Tax Act.

Depreciation

Property, plant and equiment are brought to account at cost. Plant is derpeciated on a straight line basis over 20 years.

Accumulated Funds

In the event of the winding up of the Association, accumulated funds will not be distributed to members. The funds are to be distributed to another body incorporated with a similar constitution and objectives as that of the current Association. Otherwise the funds are to be returned to the relevant body which originally granted the funds to the Associaton.

AUDIT REPORT

Scope

I have audited the special purpose financial report of the Zonta Club of Brisbane East Inc. for the year ended 31 March 2012 as set out on pages 3 to 8. The committee is responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial report. I have conducted an independent audit of these financial statements in order to express and opinion on them to the members of the association for the year ended 31 March 2012.

My audit has been conducted in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards to provide reasonable assurance as to whether the financial report is free of material misstatement. My procedures included examination, on a test basis, of evidence supporting the amounts and other disclosures in the financial report, and the evaluation of accounting policies and significant accounting estimates. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion whether, in all material respects, the financial report is presented fairly and in accordance with Accounting Standards and other mandatory professional reporting requirements and statutory requirements so as to present a view which is consistent with my understanding of the association's financial position, and the results of its operation.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.

Qualifications

Various fundraising activities, particularly membership fees and dinner meetings contribute a significant amount of the revenue for the Zonta Club of Brisbane East Inc. The Zonta Club of Brisbane East Inc. has determined that it is impracticable to establish control of the collection of cash from such fundraising activities prior to entry into its financial records. Accordingly, as the evidence available to me regarding revenue from this source was limited, our audit procedures with respect to these receipts have to be restricted to the amounts recorded in the financial records. In addition, donations of goods and services have not been accounted for in the financial statements. I am therefore unable to express and opinion whether donations received by the Zonta Club of Brisbane East Inc are complete.

Audit Opinion

In my opinion, except for the effects on the financial report of such adjustments, if any, as might have been required had the limitations on our audit procedures referred to in the qualification paragraph not existed, the financial report presents fairly in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards, other mandatory professional reporting requirements and the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (Qld) as at 31 March 2012 the financial position of the Zonta Club of Brisbane East Inc. and the results of its operations.
