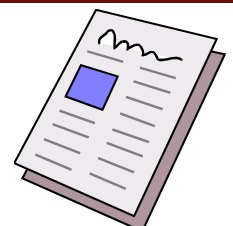

On being asked to submit a profile I have had to think how I could succinctly present this without being too drawn out .. so here goes.

I must admit that I had not thought that we would be here permanently, but two children born in Brisbane and continued acclimatization to the warmer **climate together with David's continuing enjoyment in his work, changed my thinking.**

I was delighted to be invited to join the Zonta Club of Rockhampton in 1983 as a Charter Member and as we learned more about Zonta and the possible chances to meet other women in varying Professions and with differing interests, I feel vindicated in my original agreement.

I have enjoyed the friendships and experiences that being a member has allowed me and hope to continue to enjoy helping to make a difference to my community and to those who the International Zonta wish to assist in the future.

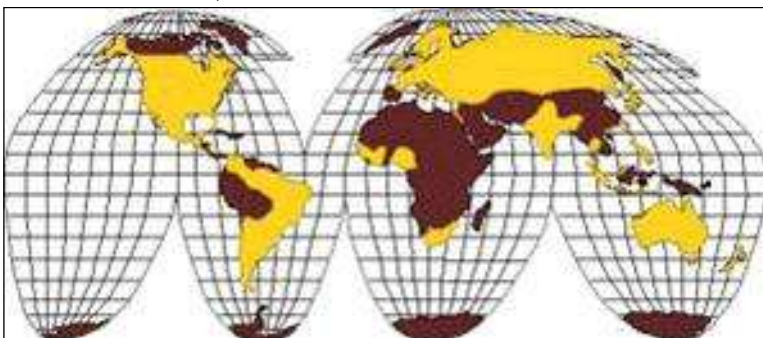
Those of us who attended the recent conference were all impressed by how smoothly it all unfolded. **That doesn't happen by accident but is the result of careful planning and attention to detail.**
