
Last night (Thursday 29.9.05) Trish (also our Area 4 Director) conducted (perhaps the first for our District 24) Zonta's first teleconference. It was

**Zonta's International Service Program:
Advocacy Through Service**

The International Service Program enables Zontians to address critical issues affecting the various aspects of status of women – their health, educational, social, political and economic well being.

Since 1956, Zonta International has funded programs in over 30 countries through contributions from Zonta clubs, individual Zontians and friends totaling US\$6,139,176 (to 2002). In the 2002-2004 Biennium, another US\$574,450 has been committed to Reinventing India (phase II), a project to combat trafficking of women in Bosnia-Herzegovina and to projects to assist women in Afghanistan.

Zonta International has partnered UN agencies in this work and has made a **significant difference** to the women supported by them. The issues addressed have also been used by Zonta members as platforms for education and advocacy within their own countries.
