Typography

Hypatia Sans Pro: Hypatia Regular **Hypatia Semibold**
Hypatia Sans Pro is the font used in the word “ZONTA” within the centennial icon. Hypatia Sans Pro is a licensed Adobe font. Hypatia Sans Pro should be used in headings and subheadings in print and electronic communications when available. There is a cost associated with using this font. To purchase Hypatia Sans Pro, go to adobe.com/type and search for “Hypatia Sans Pro.”

Lato: Lato **Lato Bold** *Lato Italic* **Lato Bold Italic**
Lato is the font used in “YEARS” within the centennial icon. Lato is an open source font that is available for free. Lato should be used for headings and subheadings when Hypatia Sans Pro is unavailable, or as body copy. To download the Lato font, go to <http://www.latofonts.com>.

Arial: Arial Arial Narrow *Arial Italic* **Arial Bold** **Arial Bold Italic**
Arial should be used in body copy.

Guidelines for Use

The centennial icon may not be altered in any way.

- Do not stretch or skew the icon
- Do not recolor the icon
- Do not add any other elements to the icon
- Do not overlap the icon on any other design elements

The centennial icon can be used in place of the Zonta International, Zonta district and Zonta club logos when used on the following materials during the 2018-2020 Biennium:

- Letterhead
- Envelopes
- Invitations
- Banners
- Name Badges
- Business Cards
- Buttons and pins
- Documents for Centennial Programs

The Zonta International, Zonta district and Zonta club logos will continue to be used on:

- Policies
- Manuals
- Operational documents
- Items to be used beyond the 2018-2020 Biennium

Using the Centennial Icon Together with the Emblem

- When designing materials that include the centennial icon, you must also include the emblem.
- The centennial icon and the emblem shall not be used next to one another, but instead used on opposite sides of work, or opposite ends of documents.
- The centennial icon and the emblem shall either be the same size, or the “Z” of ZONTA within the centennial icon shall be the same size as the “Z” element within the emblem.
