Guest Speaker – Su Marshall

Suzanne Marshall is a highly-experienced youth and community worker who holds a BA Honours Degree in Youth and Community work. She has been a professional practitioner both in the community sector and local government for 18 years.

She coordinated Torpoint Youth Project that operated within a high school in the UK for five years, primarily working with young people at risk of exclusion from school. Roles included;

- Facilitating Youth forums
- Delivering extra learning lessons for young people who could not learn in a traditional classroom environment
- Facilitating a weekly girl's groups, boys group and anti-bullying club
- Outreach

She has also worked for many years with homeless young people, supporting them in accessing housing and delivering life skills workshops to enable them to sustain their tenancies.

She currently manages the volunteer team at Women's Legal Service that support women and their children experiencing Domestic violence and family law issues




