The award honours young women who demonstrate a commitment to leadership in public policy, government and volunteer organisations.

The Rockhampton club has offered this award annually for many years and looks forward to recognising and honouring the young women of the community once again in 2016.

This award is open to young women who are aged 16 to 19 years on April 1, 2016, and live, study or work in the Central Region.

Applications are to be received by the Zonta Club of Rockhampton by Friday, February 26.

At club level, the winner will receive a certificate and a financial award.

The award is also offered at district (43 clubs - Queensland) and international level (30 districts) with the winner's application at each level submitted to the next level.

All winners receive certificates and financial awards.

Zonta Rockhampton looks forward to receiving applications from young women who meet the eligibility requirements of the award.
