Zonta International News

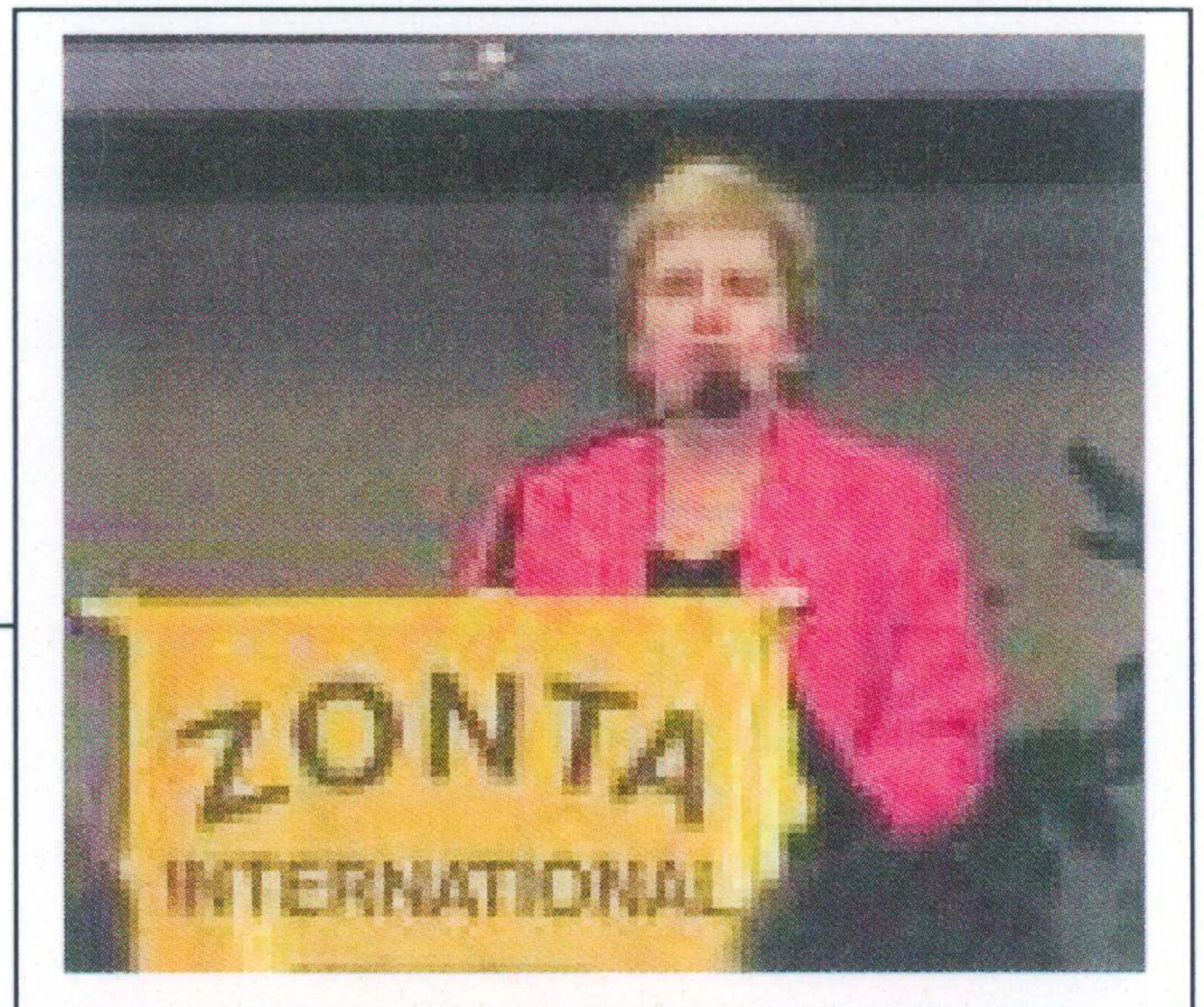

We would like to thank you for 5 years of dedicated service, for being a good friend and we will miss you heaps.

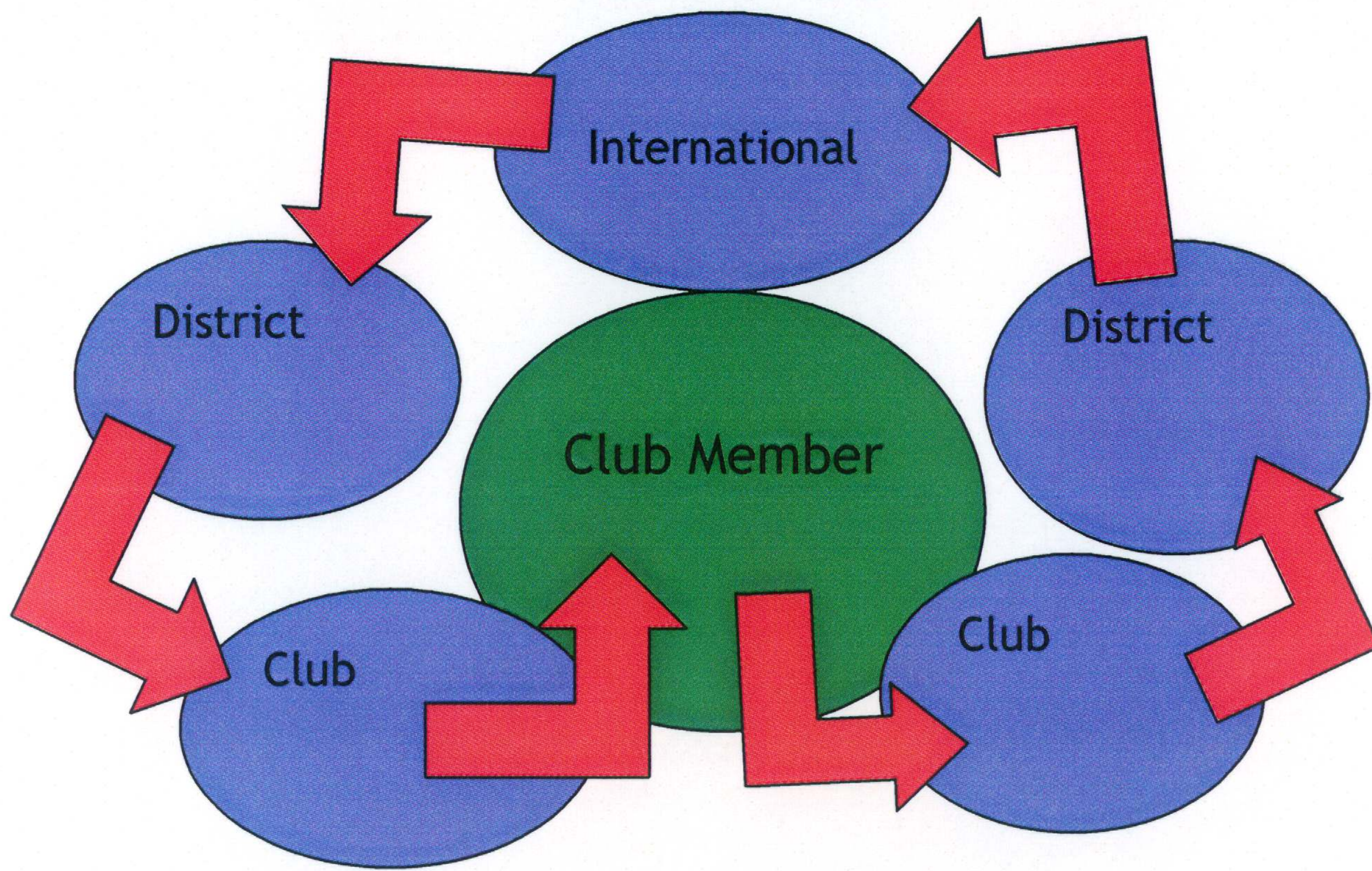
Our thought and prayers are with Rhonda Pengo as she heads out for another operation. We wish you a speedy recovery and can't wait to see you back at the Dinner meetings.
