So far, 3 high school students are coming from HHH so hopefully we may be able to extend the understanding of Zonta and its goals to a younger age group.
- Birthing Kits Feb 21st –very successful finished by early afternoon. Thanks very much to those who came and helped us all and very special thanks to Givoanna and her family as cutting the black plastic in advance seems to have halved the time taken on the assembly day. Over 500,000 kits have been done by Australian Zontians since the project started and over 80,000 kits have gone to Afghanistan which is where ours are destined this year.

BIRTHING KIT ASSEMBLY DAY

Status of Women

The morning went very quickly with 12 ladies in attendance, and we were finished by 1.30. Special thanks to Giovanna and her family for doing the black plastic in advance and putting it in the zip lock bags – we think that saves us over a day in assembly time. Also thanks to Peta for offering her premises.

As usual 1,000 kits were made and this year they are going to Afghanistan. Since the project has been running in Australia, over 500,000 kits have been sent overseas. Our target country Afghanistan, has received over 80,000 kits. We have been advised that mortality rates for infants and mothers have been reduced by up to 50%.

As a group we enjoyed a lot of laughs, some homemade treats, and once again we know we have contributed to a great cause of helping those less fortunate than us to have a right to a safe and healthy birth.


