Your local Zonta Club contributes to other international women's health issues such as the obstetric fistula program in Liberia. This continues despite the current Ebola crisis. An extract from Zonta International explains the plan protem.



An update on Liberia Fistula Project...

In light of the ongoing Ebola crisis in Liberia, many Zontians have expressed concern about the people of Liberia, especially the fistula survivors and the medical staff caring for them in the health centers supported by Zonta International. At this time, all activities related to the Zontasupported Liberia Fistula Project have been suspended to allow the medical staff to focus on responding to the Ebola crisis. Zonta International, however, remains committed to the Liberia Fistula Project and have granted an extension to UNFPA to resume project activities once the Ebola crisis is under control. UNFPA has agreed to update Zonta regularly on the status of the situation in Liberia



What else has been happening??

I was very pleased to hand over approx. 100 care packs to the Gold Coast University Hospitals Emergency Dept. Social Workers Rebecca & Lily received them for the distribution to victims of sexual assault. These packs contain shampoo, conditioner, and soap or shower gel, toothbrush and toothpaste and body lotion. We hope to make this an ongoing project as the current rate of assaults on the Gold Coast alone is averaging 1 per day. Tweed has a similar incidence.

We were also able to financially assist a student **Maddie White** to attend the National Youth Science Forum in Canberra next month. It will be our pleasure to have Maddie as a guest speaker to fill us in her trip early next year.

November 8th Zonta celebrates its 95th year as an organisation dedicated to improving the status of women

Donations from Zonta Club members and fund raising is integral to providing the money for these project to continue. Zonta International Foundation achieved the highest fundraising total in its history during the 2012-2014 Biennium. Totalling U.S \$5,101,925. This total was the result of 22,171 donations from 7,553 clubs and individual donors.

Zonta International will continue its mission of empowering women worldwide through advocacy by supporting projects and programs focusing on Preventing Root Causes through Education during 2014-2016 Biennium.

We must not forget, it is unthinkable that women and girls are mistreated in other countries simply due to a belief system that is antiquated. It is also unthinkable and unacceptable that 219 schoolgirls kidnapped 6 months ago continue to be held hostage by the Islamist militant group Boko Haram. Nigeria's expectation of a ceasefire and the release of these girls has not come to fruition.

"Esta Soler: How we turned the tide on domestic violence (Hint: the Polaroid helped)"

When Esta Soler lobbied for a bill outlawing domestic violence in 1984, one politician called it the "Take the Fun Out of Marriage Act." "If only I had Twitter then," she mused. This sweeping, optimistic talk charts 30 years of tactics and technologies — from the Polaroid camera to social media — that led to a 64% drop in domestic violence in the U.S.
