# President's Patter



A busy November with our 16 days of action for the Zonta Says No to Violence against Women campaign.

The Launch at Riverbend Books by The Hon Dame Quentin Bryce AD CVO was very successful. We should all congratulate ourselves on this campaign and whilst we recognise the importance of raising awareness we should also understand it is critical to take action. Our projects and our contributions to Zonta International allow us an

avenue to play a part in eliminating violence against women and children.

Domestic Violence is a major issue in Australian Society and the statistics around domestic and family violence are alarming.

- 4 women have been killed in Queensland over the last month as a result of Domestic Violence
- 17 women, 5 children and 4 men have been killed this year in Queensland as a result of Family and Domestic Violence
- 200 calls per day are made to Queensland Police seeking help or protection from Domestic and Family Violence
- 71 women and 12 men this year Australia-wide have been killed as a result of Family and Domestic Violence, and
- The cost of Domestic and Family Violence to the Queensland economy is estimated to be between to \$2.7 billion and \$3.2 billion.

This week 15 school staff will attend the NAPCAN LoveBites training at Yeronga SHS which we have funded. LoveBites is an extremely successful school based domestic and family violence and sexual assault prevention program aimed at Years 9 and 10 high school students.

As follow up from our November dinner meeting discussion I have written to all Presidents in Areas 1 and 3 inviting a representative from their Clubs to attend a meeting in early February in the hope we may expand some training in 2016 through partnerships with other Zonta Clubs.

Special thanks to Ros, Denise, Irene, Kerstin and Barbara for their work and support this month.

Finally to all members, best wishes for a safe and happy Christmas.
