Zonta's vision is a world in which women's rights are recognised as human rights and every woman is able to achieve her full potential.

In such a world, women have access to all resources and are represented in decision making positions on an equal basis with men. In such a world, no woman lives in fear of violence.

Our theme is Empowering Women Through Service and Advocacy. (Zonta International Vision and Mission)

Australia has historically been a nation in recognising gender equality. It was one of the first nations to offer suffrage to women in 1901. The introduction of the Sex Discrimination Act 1984, paid parental leave and compulsory education to Year 12 for all children and young people are indicators of Australia's pursuit of gender equality.

Whilst we have come so far, we still have a way to go. Women in Australia still face key human rights problems including:

- Homelessness In Australia, many women live without adequate access to basic living requirements such as housing and food. The major causes of homelessness amongst women include domestic violence, sexual assault and family breakdown.
- Violence against women (including sexual assault, domestic and family violence) Impacts upon the capacity of women to participate in social, economic and cultural life fully and equally.
- Equal participation Women experience barriers to their full and equal participation in public life, including the paid work force.
- Gender gap in income Many women in Australia have lower earnings over their lifetime than men and compared to men have significantly less retirement savings. (Women's Law Centre WA 2017)

Through our community service projects and advocacy, our Club takes action in continuing to address these issues and contribute to a vision of a society free from domestic and family violence. In the coming months up until the end of 2017, our Club will join action with Zonta Clubs across the world in engaging communities to join the *Zonta Says No Campaign* and eliminate violence against women.

I look forward to working with you on these vital projects.
