OLYMPIC swimmer Tessa Wallace was crowned the University of the Sunshine Coast's 2012 Sportsperson of the Year. Tessa became the Australian 200m breaststroke champion at the 2012 Olympic trials and was a semi-finalist in this event at the London Olympics. To make the Australian team was a huge achievement for Tessa because she had to overcome a serious knee injury and a bout of Ross River fever that almost forced her to quit the sport.
