Guest Speaker: Zoe Rathus AM, B Arts, LLB

Zoe Rathus AM is a senior lecturer in law at Griffith University. Her research is mainly in family law with a focus on gender issues and domestic and family violence. Ms Rathus worked in private practice and at the Women's Legal Service in Brisbane for over 20 years before entering academia. She has served on the Queensland Domestic Violence Council, the Taskforce on Women and the Criminal Code, the Board of Legal Aid Queensland and a number of management committees. Between 1995 and 1998 she worked extensively in South Africa on gender issues. Zoe was awarded THE Centenary Medal in 2003 for "distinguished service to the law and women's issues in Queensland" and an Order of Australia in 2011 for her services to women, the law and education.
