- Less than 5 % of working women hold senior management positions and only 10 % of women hold seats in world's parliaments

Inspiring Women



Vicki Saylor at the Australian Film Institute Awards in Melbourne Dec 2007

Vicki Saylor is the first North Queensland actor to win an Australian Film Institute award. Vicki, a proud Torres Strait Island woman from Townsville was hononured for her performance as Flo, in the SBS television drama Call Me Mum which was her first acting job. The film was directed by Margot Nash and Kathleen Mary Falon wrote the screen play.

Vicki has also received the Bendigo Bank 2007 Business Women of the Year New Challenge Award in Townsville. The former Townsville Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Cultural Events and Performance Manager has founded her own promotions and marketing business called SayLaV Marketing and Events. The New Challenge award is given to women who have been in their chosen careers for 10 years and take up a career in a different industry.

Her motto is promoting excellence in people and to do that" I have to walk the walk myself," Ms Saylor said.

Earlier in the year she attended and performed at the prestigious 29th International Women Directors' Festival in France. She also attended the Australian Embassy in Paris 50th NAIDOC Celebrations (National Aboriginal and Islanders Day Observation Committee) as the guest speaker where her film Call Me Mum was screened.

Vicki was also the guest speaker at the Young Achievement Australia Awards night in 2007. Her words were very inspirational as she charted the ups and downs of her life but her message was clear: "Never let go of your dreams!"

From the Hen's Hutch





Many women are afraid of their first mammogram, but there is no need to worry. By taking a few minutes each day for the week preceding the exam and doing the following practice exercises, you will be totally prepared. And best of all, you can do these simple practice exercises right in the privacy of your own home.

EXERCISE 1

Freeze two metal bookends overnight. Strip to the waist. Invite a stranger into the room. Press the bookends against one of your breasts. Smash the bookends together as hard as you can. Set an appointment with the stranger to meet next year and do it again.

EXERCISE 2

Open your refrigerator door and insert one breast between the door and the main box. Have one of your strongest friends slam the door shut as hard as possible and lean on the door for good measure. Hold that position for five seconds (don't breathe!). Repeat again in case the first time wasn't effective enough.

EXERCISE 3

Visit your garage at 3:00 a.m. when the temperature of the concrete floor is just perfect. Take off all your warm clothes and lay comfortably on the floor with one breast wedged under the rear tire of the car. Ask a friend to slowly back the car up until the breast is sufficiently flattened and chilled. Turn over and repeat for the other breast.


