

Member Profile – Loris Neff

I am Canadian – lived on a small family farm in Western Canada for the first 18 years on my life. The farm has been in our family for over 100 hundred years and my brother still lives there. I always wanted to travel as a child and that is what led me to travel around the world in 2001 and to visit Australia. I now have dual citizenship.

In 2001, I decided to take a year off work to travel – I became a “Midlife Runaway”. Even had business cards made up with this description. I had been divorced for many years and my daughter, my only child was through university and married. I felt it was time to “jump off” the treadmill and explore the world. I had done a lot of travelling before but just wanted to experience travel at a slower pace. So I quit my job and I was off! My daughter’s biggest fear was that I would not return to Canada and that is what actually happened.

I arrived in Australia in September 2001 for a 3 month visit and during this time I met my partner Greg. We have been together since then. I returned to Canada in 2002, sold my house and came back to Australia to live permanently.

Greg and I moved back to Canada in 2008. I wanted to be there for my daughter who now has two beautiful sons. It was wonderful to see them grow up into little boys. But Greg developed health problems due to the cold weather and we have returned to live in Brisbane again. Greg returned in 2012, returned to his old job and bought our house. I arrived January 1, 2014 – great way to start the year!

In my professional life, I was a Practice Manager for law firms. I did this for over 30 years working with very large firms (200 people) to small firms of 15 people. I am currently semi-retired and only working in a casual position two days per week as a bookkeeper.

Through all my travels I remained interested and committed to Zonta. I initially joined the Zonta Club of Bundaberg Inc in 2003 and transferred my membership to Brisbane Metro Breakfast when relocating to Brisbane. When I moved back to Canada, there was no club in Calgary. It had folded several years before my return. I re-joined Zonta and Brisbane East in May 2014.

I also have been the Treasurer for BDA (Bodhgaya Development Association) for the past four years. Our small committee of eight people (including two founding members of this NGO) has been supporting and fund raising for educational and empowerment projects in and around Bodhgaya India for women and children. I had the pleasure of visiting the Prajna Vihar School in 2017 to see directly how our support is helping the children in this area.


