President's Patter



In April, we had a small but productive Breast Cushion working bee at Jo's home. Thank you to Jo and to those who attended.

Jo and her sister Michele had made a couple of cushions with different material to showcase at the International Convention coming up in June.

This led to the question about whether other countries do this project. Kirsten mentioned that she didn't recall hearing about Zonta clubs producing breast cushions in her home country – The Netherlands.

Breast Cushions are possibly the most widely known Zonta service project in Australia. Probably because by 2013 over 50,000 cushions had been made and delivered across the country. Unfortunately, I couldn't find more updated figures, but with most Zonta clubs participating and making between 500 and 1000 per year it must be a considerable number.

This is what I have discovered about the beginning of breast cushion project that is vital to the health and well-being of so many women and men recovering from breast cancer.

The Breast Cushion was initiated by Zonta Club of Botany Bay in 1995 by a member whose friend was recovering from breast cancer surgery.

- Adopted by other Zonta Clubs in Districts across Australia progressively from 2000.
- Endorsed as a District 24 Project 2005.
- Also adopted by Zonta Clubs around the world since being showcased at the Zonta International Convention in Melbourne in 2006.

The project has been active in places as far flung as Germany, Canada, the USA, New Zealand, and Macedonia (where the project began in 2007 to mark the third anniversary of the chartering of the Zonta Club of Skopje), and in Sri Lanka in 2012 by the Zonta Club of Colombo.

Women in Business Scholarship (zonta.org)

JMK Women in Business Scholarship program helps women pursue undergraduate and master's degrees in business management.

Women of any age, pursuing a business program with major field of specialization in accounting, economics, finance, business management, business technology, information technology, marketing, operations management, human resources management, international business, or entrepreneurship at an accredited university/college/institute, who demonstrate outstanding potential in the field and are living or studying in a Zonta district/region, are eligible.

Students must be enrolled in at least the second year of an undergraduate program through the final year of a master's program at the time the application is submitted to the local Zonta club. Applicants must still be in school at the time the scholarship funds are disbursed and must not graduate before April 2025.
