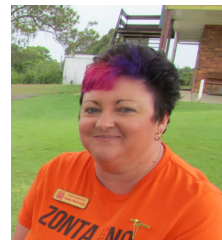
Hello Ladies,

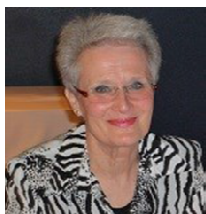
