



**Education** – Nassiga attends primary school. It takes less than 30 minutes to reach school. Nassiga's favourite subject is science.

**Health** – According to the family, Nassiga has been healthy & not suffered from any serious illness. The nearest health facility is about 30 mins away.

Project activities in Bancoumana over the past year:

- Provision of mosquito nets #
- Immunisation for children &
- pregnant mothers
- Dental checks & treatment for children

**Bancoumana** is a small town and rural commune in the Cercle of Kati in the Koulikoro Region of south-western Mali. The commune includes the town and 13 villages.[2] At the time of the 2009 census it had a population of 21,714.[1] The town of Bancoumana lies on the left bank of the River Niger 60 km southwest of Bamako, the Malian capital.

Mosquito born diseases e.g. malaria are a very significant issue in Mali. Kati district, where Nassiga lives, has some of the highest malaria transmission in Mali. Hence the importance of mosquito net distribution. Zonta on the Rocks – Advancing the Status of Women through Service and Advocacy

Since 2008, ZI has been the major funder of the Liberia Fistula Project & it is again supported as a 2012 – 2014 Biennium ZI Project - Funding: US\$1,000,000 to UNFPA (United Nations Population Fund). During the current Biennium, the program will move from project – based treatment to treatment integrated into the Government's national health system. The project will be expanded to provide support to women who have undergone unsuccessful fistula repair surgeries and women with fistulae that cannot be surgically repaired.
