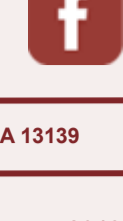

Welcome to all for our first newsletter of 2016. The enthusiasm was evident at our January meeting, so I sincerely hope this continues throughout the year.

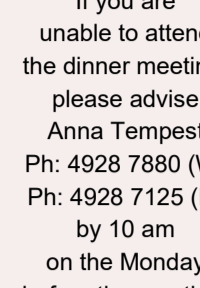

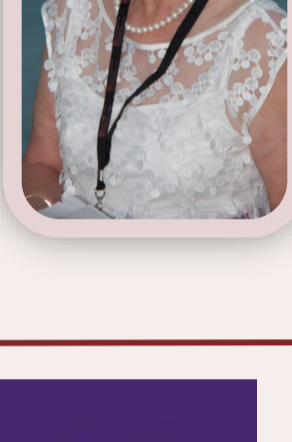


### Visit by District Governor: Tuesday 16 February:

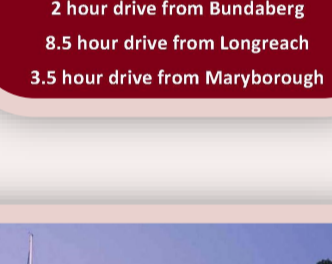
So make a difference, think globally and act locally! Make every day International Women's Day. Do your bit to ensure that the future for girls is bright, equal, safe and rewarding.

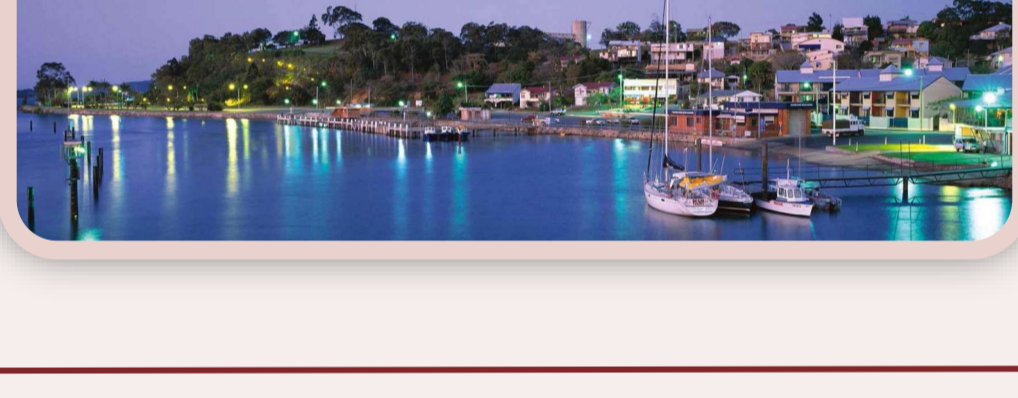
### Area 2 Meeting: 08-10 April 2016

### Orange Ladies:



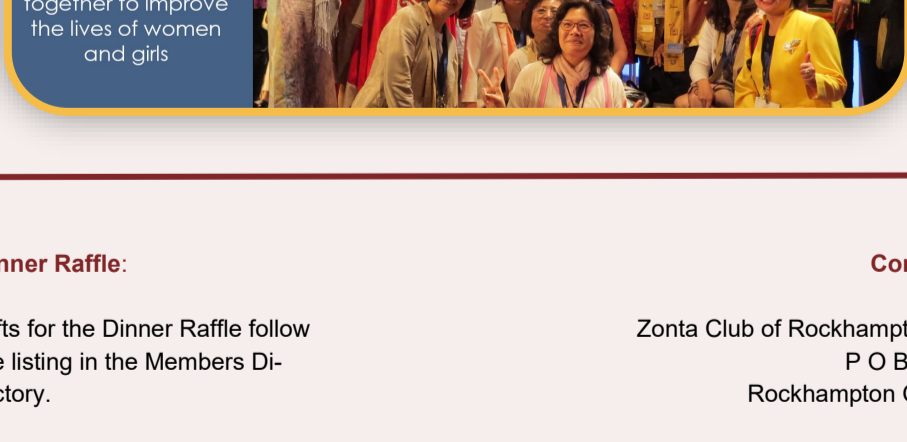
Many thanks to Judie who has organized the making of orange ladies to be used for the 'Zonta says NO to Violence against Women' campaign.
