In 2016, UNICEF and the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) joined forces to launch the Global Programme to Accelerate Action to End Child Marriage. In 2018, at the International Convention, members voted to support this global program with a commitment of \$2 million, and in doing so became the first private sector donor. As Zonta begins its centennial biennium, UNICEF USA is proud to partner with Zonta once again in support of UNICEF and UNFPA programs to reach the world's most excluded and marginalized girls.


